
Today

Conferences

The NAESC Engineering Leadership Summit (ELS) is a national-level event hosted by a member school every year in the spring. Each of our 35+ universities is invited, resulting in a conference that hosts **the country's top engineering student leaders**. They engage in various activities aimed at providing **personal and professional growth opportunities and improving their council's social impact**. Some of these include competitions hosted by corporate partners, keynote speakers, a career fair, and a Voter Delegates' Meeting to discuss the governance and operations of our nonprofit.

The NAESC Regional Conferences are similar to the NAESC ELS, focusing on **building** relationships and improving the engineering experience at member schools.
